

you need:

- 1–6 dice
- 2–10 number cards
- pens and squared paper
- multiplication tables chart

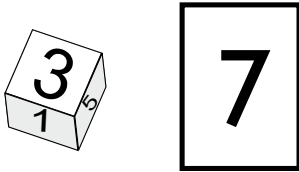
Rectangle multiplications for 2 players

When it is your turn

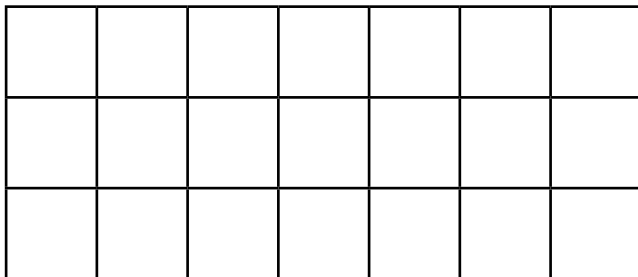
Turn the multiplication tables chart face down so that your partner can't see it.

Take a number card and roll the dice, both in secret.

Draw a rectangle to match the numbers.



For example, if your numbers are 3 and 7, draw a 3×7 rectangle.



Your partner must **quickly**

- say your two numbers
- say the number of squares in your rectangle.

Counting the squares in ones is banned.

Show your partner your dice and number card and check with your tables chart to see if they are correct.

The end of the game

Keep taking turns like this.

There is no winner.
